Adult Volunteer Fellowship/Event Planner/Team

The AVF Planner/Team will plan monthly or bi-monthly fellowship gatherings for the adult volunteers, so that they can build relationships with new volunteers, and discuss new ideas or plans for youth activities. (This includes finding a fellowship location/host, contacting the adult volunteers, and planning the details of the event. It can be very simple, like chips and dip snacks.)

Volunteer Co-coordinator

This person will contact/gather adult volunteers/chaperones for irregular events, such as, off campus functions, lock-ins, retreats, or other events that require extra adults.

Transportation Team

As part of this team, you will be asked to drive students to special events off campus and return them back to the church. You may also be asked to drive a church van if student numbers require a large vehicle. You will not be required to stay at the events, but you will need to be back in time to bring the students back to church. You may not have to drive for every event if we have enough volunteers.

Advertising/Graphic Design team

This will be a team that will brainstorm ideas, and help to create the finished product. We need help with designing flyers/posters, t-shirts, mail outs and more.

____Special Events Volunteer

This person is willing to Sponsor/Chaperone events that do not occur weekly. Events may include weekend retreats, mission projects, lock-ins and other non-weekly events. You will not be required to attend all of these events.

____Sunday School Teachers ** (New 2 month rotation!)****

This person will be paired with a Sunday School Shepherd, and you will prepare and teach the lesson. The Shepherd is there to assist you in any way needed, but you will be leading the discussion and activities. A curriculum will be provided with detailed plans and instruction. Sunday School teachers are on a 2 month rotation.

____Sunday School Shepherd ** (New Volunteer opportunity!)****

The shepherd is there to assist the teacher in anyway needed but is first and foremost, the nurturer of the Sunday School class. This person is in charge of taking role every week. They also send postcards to youth when they miss classes and for their birthday. They keep up with the kids' lives and build relationships that show the kids that they are cared for. This is a year long commitment, but is incredibly rewarding.

____Cafe' Ignite (Sundays 9 – 10am)

____Cafe' Ignite (Wednesday 6:15 – 8:00pm)

This position will rotate monthly or bi-monthly depending on the number of volunteers we receive. You will be paired with another volunteer, and you will prepare simple coffee drinks for the youth on Sunday mornings or Wednesday evenings. There will be a hands-on training, as well as detailed instructions in the café for locating items, making drinks, and clean up.

The pair will be given a list of snack choices, and must choose one to prepare on their designated night. They will split the cost of the meal. Financial assistance is available upon request. The pair will also clean the kitchen area after the youth have finished eating. Once everything is clean you are free to go home. Training will be provided, so that you know how to use our industrial kitchen appliances, and where items are located. All parents are required to serve at least one meal during the year.
